“Well, you shoulda been there. We talked Loss-of-Control, how 80% of it is less than 1000’, and how fast things can go south. Lots of good input from members. We discussed inadvertent flight into IMC and how that can lead to loss-of control. Then we moved to instrument scan and how that could save your life. Attached is the PowerPoint I would have used with various instrument scan techniques. All members weighed in on which they used or liked, and positive/negative points about each. I was happy with the member attention and input. One guy started recording it so you would have to suffer thru it too.”
