- 1. A reminder to stop at the gate to prevent unauthorized access to the Airport. This reminder was because of recent events at the Airport including vandalism of an aircraft.
- 2. Update for the funding on the 14L/32R paving project. Funds are expected next week.
- 3. The FAA inspection went well with two discrepancies. Airport Operations is working to correct those.
- 4. Fire main repair at 280/288 Buchanan Field road is almost complete at a cost of approximately \$200,000.00.
- 5. Developments are continuing on the Airport.
- 6. The John Muir Fundraising event is going to happen again this year at the Apex facility.

SAFETY FORUM

Moderator - Ron Lem

This forum was tailored to the RV and Experimental pilots on the airport. Ron addressed the use of Flight Following which is provided as a service by the FAA controllers, when time permits.

Comment:

John Potter of MDPA related that the Forum has evolved over the years to serve as a place for pilots to share their experience in regards to safety. It is dedicated to the idea of "Root Cause Analysis" after an event to understand the cause of the episode that led to the event. He provided the clear evidence of doing such analysis by citing an example in the case of submarine history where the Navy had to substantially enhance the ability of crews to safely get back to the surface after a failed dive.

We must look out for each other ---- MDPA's "safety culture".
