The first-Saturday breakfast last February 1<sup>st</sup> featured another great turnout among members for memorable hangar flying and an outstanding safety seminar. And, of course, breakfast cuisine par excellence, thanks to our volunteer cooks and members bringing side dishes.

An important goal for your humble BC is to bring some healthy diversity to the monthly breakfast menu, without abandoning any of our customary dishes. The concept is that offering some lighter, heart-healthy alternatives may attract more members than our 40-50 "breakfast regulars," bringing more people into the safety seminars and fly-outs. For the March breakfast (March 7th), one member has volunteered a fresh fruit salad, and your BC will bring a vegan side dish, in addition to our usual bacon, sausage, eggs (2 ways!), biscuits, gravy, grits, bad coffee, etc.

At the February breakfast, our president, Rich Cunningham, brought up the need to increase the breakfast donation, which has been \$5/member for decades. Apparently our groceries have run at a loss for some time. By near-unanimous vote of the members present, the donation was increased to \$10. Hopefully this will not be increased again for another few decades. It also was decided that volunteer cooks will be exempt from the donation.

Your BC asks that members understand this was independent of the plan to develop a broader menu. However, the increase will bring plenty of funding to reimburse members voluntarily bringing side dishes.

# **Director of Airports' Comments**

The Director of Airports discussed the following items:

- The Runway 14L/32R pavement reconstruction project is expected to start the week of April 13, 2020. Work will also include repairs to the concrete pads on Runway 01L/19R. The entire project require approximately 120 days
- Ground water testing, as required by the CA Water Board, is expected to start the week of February 24, 2020 and will continue for 3-4 weeks.
- FAA is reporting that the Class D airspace will be expanding from 2.8 miles to 4.1 miles on May 21, 2020.
- The 12<sup>th</sup> annual tenant and business marketing BBQ is planned for Thursday, May 7, 2020.

We must look out for each other --- MDPA's "safety culture".
